Soybeans belong to the legume family. The beans are the seeds of the leguminous soybean plant. They can grown on a variety of soil and in a wide range of climates, soybeans are versatile as they can be used as whole beans, soy sprouts or processed as a variety of food items such as soy milk, tofu, soy, sauce, soy oil and soy dairy alternatives. They are also used for making candles and bio - diesel.

Soy is an excellent sources of high quality protein; is low in saturated fats and is cholesterol free. In recent times it has been highly recommended because of its ability to lower the levels of low density lipoprotein (LDL) a bad cholesterol.

An easy way to take soy is as Soymilk now available with added flavour. Soymilk does not contain lactose (milk sugar) can be drunk by those who are allergic to normal milk.
