PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to sanction incentive increment in the post of B.T. Assistant for acquiring P.G. Degree qualification acquired by the petitioner with effect from 11.06.2016, in accordance with the sanctioned order issued by the District Educational Officer. Chennai vide Proceedings East in Na.Ka.No.2985/Aa3/2019 dated 12.09.2019, by accepting the Bill for the same, without reference to G.O.Ms.No.37, P&AR Department dated 10.03.2020, along with interest for delay in payment of incentive increment till date of payment, based on the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 25.10.2023, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.



ORDER

- 2. The petitioner herein has given representation to the respondents on 25.10.2023, seeking to sanction his incentive increment in the post of B.T. Assistant along with interest. Since the said representation has not been considered till date, the present Writ Petition has been filed.
- **3.** It is needless to point out that whenever a representation of this nature is made to a Statutory Authority, there is a duty cast upon them to consider the same on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in one way or other, instead of keeping the same pending indefinitely. As such, non-consideration of the representation by the Statutory Authority would amount to dereliction of duty and hence, this Court will be justified in invoking its extraordinary powers under Article 226 of Constitution of India and direct them to consider the same within a stipulated time.


