In the course of Evolution, man developed the ability to build his own shelters in convenient locations using the materials available locally. The concept of fabricated permanent shelters thus came into being. The term 'shelter' as a basic necessity is perceived differently by different people. People at times temporarily stay in farm houses for rest and relaxation. They stay there to manage Cultivation and Farming activities as well. Some People reside in ranch house in order to monitor and take care of vast stretches of private lands that are usually not fenced. Man has thus learnt not only to put a roof over his head but also in a way that suits all his needs.
