15. Find intervals of concavity and points of inflexion for the function $f(x) = \frac{1}{2}(e^x - e^{-x})$.

41. (a) In a murder investigation, a corpse was found by a detective at exactly 8 p.m. Being alert, the detective also measured the body temperature and found it to be 70°F. Two hours later, the detective measured the body temperature again and found it to be 60°F. If the room temperature is 50°F, and assuming that the body temperature of the person before death was 98.6°F, at what time did the murder occur? [$\log(2.43) = 0.38782$; $\log(0.5) = -0.69315$] (OR)
- (b) Investigate the values of λ and μ in system of linear equations
 $2x + 3y + 5z = 9, 7x + 3y - 5z = 11, 2x + 3y + \lambda z = \mu$, have
 i) no solution ii) a unique solution iii) an infinite number of solution
42. (a) If $z = x + iy$ and $\arg\left(\frac{z-1}{z+2}\right) = \frac{\pi}{4}$, show that $x^2 + y^2 + 3x - 3y + 2 = 0$. (OR)
- (b) The volume of a cylinder is given by the formula $V = \pi r^2 h$. Find the greatest and least values of V if $r + h = 6$.
43. (a) Find the area of the region common to the circle $x^2 + y^2 = 1$ and the parabola $y^2 = 6x$. (OR)

46. (a) Verify (i) closure property, (ii) commutative property, (iii) associative property, (iv) existence of identity, and (v) existence of inverse for the operation \oplus_{11} on a subset $A = \{1, 3, 4, 5, 7\}$ of the set of remainders $\{0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10\}$. (OH)
- (b) Find the vector parametric, vector non-parametric and Cartesian forms of the equation of the plane passing through the points $(-1, 2, 0)$, $(2, 2, -1)$ and parallel to the straight line $\frac{x-1}{1} = \frac{y+1}{2} = \frac{z+1}{-1}$.
47. (a) A tunnel through a mountain for a four lane highway is to have a elliptical opening. The total width of the highway (not the opening) is to be 11m, and the height at the edge of the road must be sufficient for a truck 4m high to clear if the highest point of the opening is to be 5m approximately. How wide must the opening be? (OH)
- (b) A conical water tank with vertex down of 12 metres height has a radius of 5 metres at the top. If water flows into the tank at a rate 10 cubic metres, how fast is the depth of the water increasing when the water is 8 metres deep?
