Sub: Treasuries and Accounts - Kalanjiyam (IFHRMS 2.0) - Dearness Allowance enhanced from 46% to 50% w.e.f Jan 2024 - Instructions - reg.

Ref: G.O.(MS)No. 132, Finance (Allowance) Department, Dated: 12.03.2024.

In the Government Order read above, Government has enhanced the dearness allowance payable to State Government employee from 46% of basic pay to 50% of basic pay with effect from 01.01.2024.

Further, the Government has also requested the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts to issue necessary instructions to all Drawing and Disbursing Officers while presenting the arrear bill on the revised rates of Dearness Allowance. (Copy of the G.O enclosed herewith).

In this regard, the following instructions are issued for the drawal of DA arrear claims for the period of 3 months from January 2024 to March 2024.

1. DA percentage will be enhanced to 50% in the IFHRMS portal centrally on 02.04.2024. The enhanced DA will be reflected automatically from April 2024 pay bill after centralized payroll run on 20.04.2024.
2. DA arrears for the period of three months (Jan - March,2024) may be

claimed by the DDOs during 2nd week of April 2024.
