#### **Consonant clusters**

#### **Consonant cluster (Ending)**

#### **Objectives:**

- To know the consonant clusters in English.
- To know the one letter and two letter words in English with its pronunciation.
- To know the CVC (Consonant Vowel Consonant) words and Sight words.

#### **Consonant Cluster:**

- A consonant blend, also known as a consonant cluster, is a series of consonants that appear together before or after a vowel in a word.
- Consonant blends can be made up of either two or three letters, and can appear at the beginning, middle, or end of a word.
- Blends that appear at the beginning of a word are called **beginning blends**.

#### **Instructions to Teachers:**


- Introduce the consonant blends one by one to the students with many examples.
- Blend the word carefully and slowly.
- Ask the students to repeat after the teacher and practice the sound.
- Ask the students to write the sounds and its examples in their note book.

#### **Consonant Cluster – Ending blends:**

- A consonant blend, also known as a consonant cluster, is a series of consonants that appear together before or after a vowel in a word.
- Consonant blends can be made up of either two or three letters, and can appear at the beginning, middle, or end of a word.
- Blends that appear at the ending of a word are called **Ending blends**.

# **CVC Words**

- CVC words are consonant-vowel-consonant words.
- CVC words are the first step to teach kids reading English words.
- As the name suggests C-V-C, we have one vowel sound in between each CVC word.
- A CVC word is a single syllable three-phoneme (sound) word.

#### **Instructions to the teachers:**


- Introduce CVC to the students with many examples.
- Let's go in the vowel order a, e, i, o and u.
- Repetition drill plays the vital role in familiarising these words to the late bloomers.
- Give oral drill first and ask the students to copy the words in their note book.
