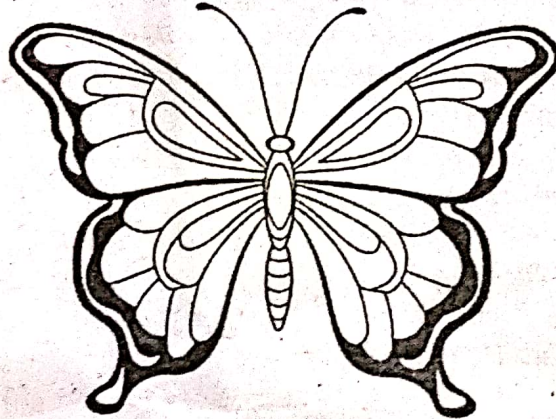

She represented India in the 2006 Common Wealth Games, Air Rifle singles, and Women's 10m Air Rifle pairs. In 2009, in the 50m Rifle 3 positions, she won a bronze and in 50m Rifle prone game held in Germany. In the 2016 Common wealth Games, she won one bronze and two silver medals in the Women's 50 m Rifle prime pairs, the women's 50m Rifle prone singles, and the women's 50m Rifle 3 positions respectively. Tejaswini was the first Indian Shooter to win a gold medal at the World Championship in 50m Rifle prone Game.
