With reference to the Proceedings 1st cited, the roles and responsibilities of each of the functionaries involved in National Achievement Survey (NAS), 2024 have been communicated to the District Level Coordinators (DLCs) for having clear understanding on the entire process of NAS, 2024.

With reference to the letter 2nd cited, it has been informed that printing of NAS, 2024 question papers and questionnaires will be undertaken at the national level and materials will be despatched to the Registered Custodian Centre (RCC) in the name of the Chief Controlling Officer (CCO) of respective district nominated by the District Magistrate.

With reference to the letter 3rd cited, NCERT has intimated that NAS, 2024 would be conducted on 4th December, 2024 and the States and UTs have been requested to nominate the State level and District level functionaries and Field Investigators (FIs) on or before 30th of this month. The district wise number of FIs required for each grade along with 10% of reserve FIs is enclosed.

The teacher trainees of D.El.Ed., B.Ed., M.Ed., courses, UG and PG students of Arts and Science Colleges and Grade 11 students can be involved as Field Investigators for conducting the survey in the sampled schools. As the number of the trainces in D.El.Ed., course is insufficient, the Director, Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai and the Vice-Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Teacher Education University, Chennai have been requested to extend support to the DLCs by allowing the trainees of B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses and students of Arts and Science Colleges to discharge their duties as additional Field Investigators in all districts.

Hence, the District Level Coordinators (DLCs) are kindly requested to identify the FIs required for each district and fill in the Excel Worksheet sent through WhatsApp and send the filled in Worksheet on or before 29.09.2024. Besides, DLCs-CEOs are requested to get the details of CCO nominated by the respective District Magistrate and the address of the RCC and fill in the google link already sent to your office mail. As the list is to be sent to NCERT on 30th of this month, the DLCs are instructed to accord top priority to this and complete the task.
