In the letter 5th read above, the Director, Department of Environment and Climate Change has stated that 25 schools have been selected for the year 2022-2023 followed by selection of 46 schools as next phase and 26 Schools were selected for the year 2023-2024 to implement the Green School Scheme and the project work is being carried out in the schools based on the component wise breakup as mentioned in para-1 above.
