At the age of 17, she captained the Tamil Nadu Women's under 19 cricket team in a national tournament in 1997, and registered its only victory ever. She was also a state-level gold winner in 50m breaststroke swimming event. But the following year, she suffered a spinal cord injury in an accident in Puducherry that left her quadriplegic.
