The saltwater constitutes about 97.2 percent and surface water is only about 2.8 % .out of this 2.8 % about 2.2 % is available as surface water and remaining 0.6 percentage of groundwater.

From this 2.2% of surface water 2.15 person is available in the form of glaciers and ice caps, 0.01% lakes and streams and the remaining 0.04% is in other forms. only about 0.25% of the total groundwater of 0.6 % can be economically extracted with the person drilling technology.
