

Preethi Srinivasan is a farmer cricketer from Tamilnadu who played domestic cricket in the 1990's. At the age of eight, she was the youngest girl to play in the state cricket team. If the age of 17, she captained the Tamilnadu women's cricket team in a national tournament in 1997 and registered its only victory ever. She was also a state-level gold winner in 50m breast stroke swimming event. But the following year, she suffered a spinal cord injury in an accident Puducherry that left her quadriplegic. Her own trauma inspired her to create soul free, a foundation that aims to help Indian youth to cope with disabilities related to spinal cord injuries and how suitable precautions can help them out, Instead of the term 'differently abled' soul free employs the term 'positive abled' for those who are suffering from a disability.
