Bombay is often regarded as India's Capital of Hope. Bombay consists of seven islands, joined by land reclamation. Many Indians, especially those from the rural areas, regard Bombay as their paradise, since they could find work relatively easily here, as compared to their homelands. Being the pillar for revenue collection, Bombay's economic growth has far outperformed the other cities. In fact, its per capita(head) production of goods and services is about three times greater than that of Delhi- India's Second most prosperous city.
